ANNUAL DUES STRUCTURE

Manufacturing Members

Up to 1 million square yards of sales per year \$2,250

Plus \$0.00075 per square yard sold per year on all square yards over 1 million

Maximum dues payment of \$20,000

Associate Members

Net dollar sales into the separate cushion industry in the preceding year, including that estimated to produce scrap which is used to make bonded underlay

Up to \$2.5 million	\$2,250
Up to \$5 million	\$3,750
Up to \$10 million	\$5,700
Up to \$15 million	\$7,500
More than \$15 million	\$18,000

Dues invoices for the upcoming year are to be sent to members on December 1 of each year, payable on February 1 of the following year.

For Manufacturing Members, dues are to be calculated on the number of square yards shipped in the year ending June 30 of the previous year.

For Associate Members, dues are to be calculated on dollar sales to the industry for the year ending October 1 of the previous year.
