ANNUAL DUES STRUCTURE

Manufacturing Members - Effective January 1, 2004

Up to 1 million yards of shipments \$2,250

Plus \$0.000750 per yard shipped on all yards over 1 million

Maximum payment of \$27,000

Associate Members - Effective January 1, 2004

Net dollar sales into the separate cushion industry in the preceding year, including that estimated to produce scrap which is used to make bonded underlay.

Up to \$2.5 million \$2,250

Up to \$5 million \$3,750

Up to \$10 million \$5,700

Up to \$15 million \$7,500

More than \$15 million \$18,000

Dues invoices for the upcoming year are to be sent to members on October 1 of each year, payable on February 1 of the following year.

For Manufacturing Members, dues are to be calculated on the number of yards shipped in the year ending June 30 of the previous year.
